Summary of Rulemaking Action:

The Rhode Island Works Program (R.I. Gen. Laws Chapter 40-5.2-1 et seq.) establishes the legal basis for a welfare to work program to assist needy families to prepare for, accept and retain employment with necessary supports, as quickly as possible, and is the law through which the Federal assistance program, Temporary Assistance for Needy Families, is available to families in Rhode Island who meet program eligibility criteria. This Direct Final Amendment is being filed to implement the Legislative changes that were signed by the Governor with the 2024 Rhode Island State Budget. These changes were effective July 1st, 2023.

The regulatory changes proposed in this filing are identical to the regulatory language currently in effect as of 08/26/2023. The effective version was originally noticed for public comment on 07/27/2023. During that public comment period, a technical error within the RICR system may have prevented comments submitted through RICR's attachment field from being received by the agency. Any comments submitted directly through RICR's text box option (with no attachments) or submitted directly to the agency were processed successfully.

As a result of the technical error, the agency is repromulgating the regulatory changes (effective as of 08/26/2023) to ensure that the public has full access to submit public comments as originally intended. The regulatory language included in this notice redlines changes made in the most recent promulgation. The agency is noticing these changes for additional public comment.

The Agency does not expect this filing to be controversial and therefore, a public hearing will not be held.

Additional Information and Public Comments:

If no formal objection is received on or before November 4, 2023, the Department of Human Services will file the Amendment and the Final Rule will take effect on this date.

Regulatory Analysis Summary and Supporting Documentation:

The Department of Human Services is filing the following changes to the Rhode Island Works Rule as a Direct Final Amendment to update the category of pregnant applicant. These changes were approved with the 2024 Rhode Island State Budget and will ensure that pregnant applicants will be reviewed for eligibility for the Rhode Island Works Program from the time they submit verification of the pregnancy:

- Section 2.2 A. 16., 25., 26., 2.5.8 A. 2., 2.11.2 E. 1., 2.12.1 C. 2., and 2.18.3 A. 4.
